# Getting your quince session *perfect!*

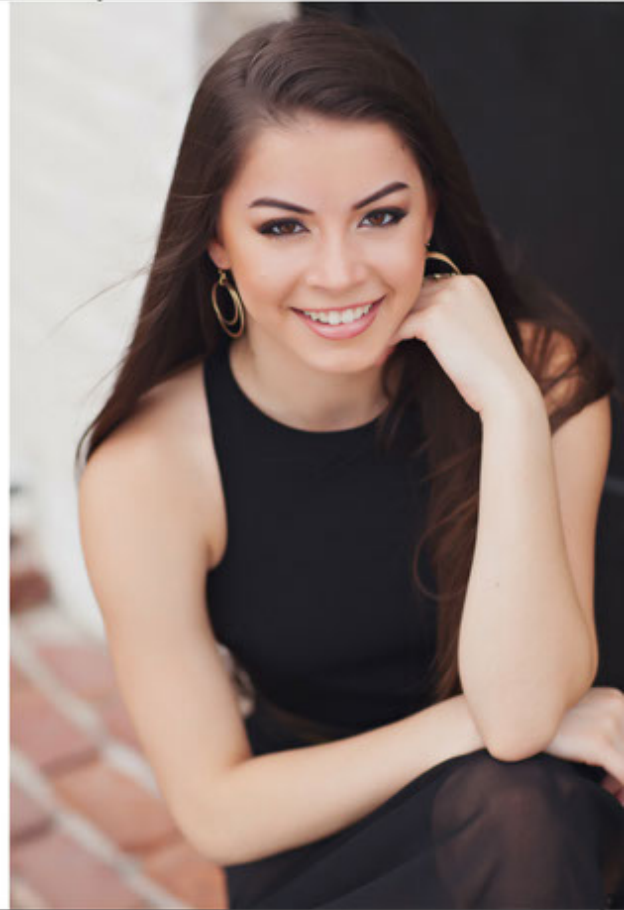

1. Groom
2. Professional makeup

4. Make it personal

# 1. Groom

Depending on when your session is taking place it is always a good idea to wax/thread your eyebrows or any facial hair you would like removed a week before your session. Make sure you have done it before and that you are not allergic to the wax. Always use a professional!



# 2. Professional Makeup



We all love to play around with makeup but on a day like this, the professional needs to take over. Let yourself get pampered! Come to your session without any makeup on and your face moisturized. Also check out my Pinterest board for tons of ideas of quinceañera makeup.

## 3. Amazing Outfits

Killer amazing outfits will make or break your session. You always want to select outfits that will flatter your body type. If you are not sure ask the expert (mom, grandma, photographer). At your session you can vary from a glammed up dress to a casual chic romper. Don't forget accessories are our secret BFF's. Adding a hat, scarf, necklace will make your images stand out.



## 4. Make it Personal



Your friend and her friend already did their quince session but you have not. Don't fret about looking like them. Instead include *YOU* in your session. Do you play the guitar, dance, cheer, scuba dive, sketch, skateboard, golf, write, sing? Infuse this nugget of your personality in your session. A few images including this will make it so much more meaningful.

# 5. Confidence

This may be the hardest one but I suggest meeting with your photographer before your session. The day of the session you want to feel comfortable and not feel awkward about how to pose. Establishing a relationship with your photographer at a pre-consultation will allow you to get to know each other and trust this person with your most precious images.
